# This or that? Mini debates

Find a list of "This or That" questions and translate it to your language. If using a specific topic, come up with specific questions.

### Step 1

Ask attendees to stand up. Tell them that one side of the room is "This", and the other side is "That".

### Step 2

Read out the first "This or that" in your language (e.g. bus or train?). Attendees will go to the side of the room that represents their preference.

### Step 3

There are two options here. You can either ask attendees to justify their choices, or have a "mini debate" where they tell the other side why their choice is better. You could allocate points to the attendee that you think is the most convincing. After 10 This or That questions, the attendee with the most points is the winner.

## Examples of This or That questions:

Apple or Android? Dogs or cats? Summer or winter? Book or movie? Coffee or tea? Instagram or TikTok? Morning or night? Train or plane? Call or text?

Pizza or pasta?
